



## Safeguarding Training Requirements for Coaches, Team Managers and Camp and Event Welfare Officers

GBS has reviewed its safeguarding training requirements and now requires all our coaches, team managers and camp and event welfare officers to undergo safeguarding training regularly. BASI, SSE, SSS and SSW will all be making safeguarding training a Licencing requirement for coaches at renewal (Autumn 2015).

### Which course?

- 1) Initially you must do the face to face SportsCoach UK “Safeguarding and Protecting Children” (SPC). It is likely you will have completed this in the past.
- 2) Three years later, you can choose to do a face to face sport safeguarding course, or an online e-learning sports safeguarding course.

**Why?** You need to be aware of good safeguarding practice in snowsports and know what to do if you see or hear something that causes you concern, or if a child tells you something that causes them concern. By completing a safeguarding course every 3 years, we can ensure all who work with children for GBS are up to date with best practice and you can be confident in your approach when working with children.

**When?** Before your next trip abroad with GBS athletes under the age of 18. Please forward a copy of your certificate to the office.

### How do I book a course?
